DEPOSIT & PAYMENT POLICY:

- The standard deposit amount is 50% of the total travel arrangement costs due on the date of confirmation and or receipt of the invoice.
 - A 20% Non-refundable deposit is required.
- Full payment is due 8 weeks prior to arrival date, after which our cancellation fees escalate in accordance with our cancellation policy. Please note that you are welcome to make staggered payments after the deposit has been made should this make it easier for you. Kindly use your name as a reference.
- Should a booking be made 6 (six) weeks before the arrival date, full payment is required to secure the booking.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

Cancellation fees are levied when guests cancel confirmed reservations. The costs of the cancellation fees will escalate the closer the guest/s cancels to their confirmed departure date. The penalties are tiered as follows:

- 5% cancellation fee if cancelled less than 60 days prior to arrival.
- 25% cancellation fee if cancelled less than 42 days prior to arrival
- 60% cancellation fee if cancelled less than 21 days prior to arrival.
- 100% cancellation fee if cancelled less than 7 days prior to arrival or a no-show.
